Day 3 Saturday, November 9

Louisville Slugger Museum

You don't have to be a baseball fan to love Louisville Slugger Museum & Factory. It's iconic, it's linked to legends, and it is one of Louisville's best known tourist attractions. This tour is fascinating with interactive exhibits that are fun. Baseball is such a big part of American history and culture that even your customers who don't think they're fans will find a connection here.

Kentucky Bourbon Trail Guidebook and Passport

Tour Prohibition Craft Spirits

Next you take a step back in time for a Prohibition-themed distillery tour! See the “tools” bootleggers used to make moonshine in the early '20s when alcohol was prohibited. Walk among a collection of historical memorabilia of the era. You'll hear true accounts of the crazy and often dangerous things that were done to illegally produce, transport, and sell liquor. Experience how they handcraft liquor today and the similarities between now and then. After the tour, wander over to our tasting bar and enjoy our spirits. You'll likely want to try PCS Distilling Company's newest creation — “NULU™” a Blue Agave Reposado imported from Mexico, then brought home to Louisville to age in Bourbon Barrels.

Free Time for Lunch and Shopping

You then have free time for lunch on your own at 4th Street Live. A 350,000 square foot entertainment and retail complex located on Fourth Street between Liberty and Muhammad Ali Blvd. Afterwards continue with your bourbon tour.

Evan Williams Bourbon Experience

Next, your group will tour The Evan Williams Bourbon Experience. It features an artisanal distillery, guided historical tour. Celebrating the legacy of Evan Williams, Kentucky's first distiller, this immersive experience brings to life the history and tradition of Kentucky's native spirit. Your tour includes a demonstration on how to make Kentucky's native cocktail - The Mint Julep.

Wine and Bourbon Tasting

At Taste Fine Wines and Bourbons, your focus is fine wines from smaller vineyards in Europe, the Americas, South Africa and New Zealand, among others. On the bourbon side, you look for Kentucky distillers who produce in smaller batches, controlling quality and creating bourbons with smooth, rich flavors.

Dinner at Derby Dinner Playhouse

This evening your group will enjoy the dinner buffet at The Derby Dinner Playhouse along with a show that will be announced closer to date.

Day 4 Sunday, November 10

Lights Under Louisville

This morning, before leaving Louisville, you drive your bus into the Mega Cavern for Lights Under Louisville Display. Every year the Cavern is transformed into an underground holiday light spectacular for the Christmas season. Sit back and enjoy a 30-minute tour. What better way to get in the holiday spirit than to witness more than four million points of lights on over 900 displays!
